



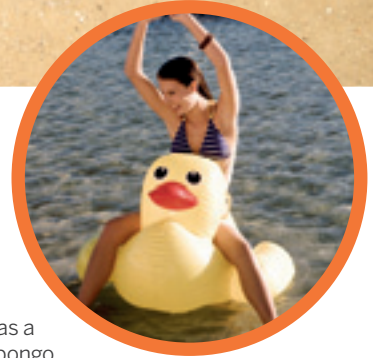
FLIP DOWN MEMORY LANE

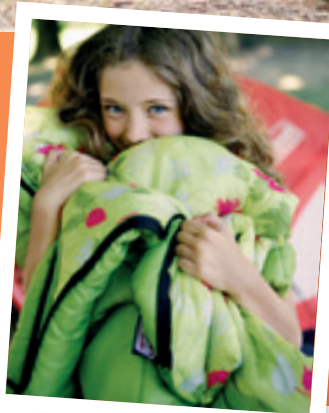
LIFE'S A BEACH
